ROAD

Accessible by three Interstates; I-165 overlays 70 miles of the 72-mile-long William H. Natcher Green River Parkway between Bowling Green and Owensboro. From there, the four-lane U.S. Hwy 231 connects to I-64 leading into Indiana. Parkway access is another benefit the Owensboro area has to offer. The Audubon Parkway connects Henderson and Owensboro, in northwestern Kentucky. A four lane Audubon Parkway is, "The Future I-69 Spur," 23 miles connect Henderson and Owensboro, Kentucky.



AIR

The Owensboro-Daviess County Airport (OWB) has both an 8,000 and 5,000-foot runway.

Direct flights from Owensboro are offered to hub cities, such as St. Louis, Missouri and Sanford, Florida. OWB has recently launched a pilot training program in partnership with Cape Air and MidAmerica Jet. The U.S. is approximately 117,000 pilots short of demand due to retirement and changes in required training. This program is designed to enhance the talent pipeline and find solutions to the pilot shortage.



RIVER

The Owensboro Riverport Authority is the largest and most profitable public port in Kentucky. It is a 285-acre port with a 40-acre rail loop and two 110-ton capacity cranes. The terminal operations specialize in handling aluminum, steel, zinc, grain, steel tanks, fertilizer, equipment and other various bulk commodities. With available on-site warehouse space and rail site adjacent to the Ohio River, the Owensboro Riverport Authority can offer intermodal service to meet your needs.
